

The **Delaware Freight Plan** is a compilation of statewide transportation planning insights that focus on improving Delaware's multimodal freight transportation systems to enhance economic opportunities within the state and the surrounding region, while also upholding federal requirements for state freight planning.

DelDOT completed the latest plan in December 2022 with approval by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) on January 24, 2023. The next four-year major plan update will be due in 2026.




