- A crisis level need has gone unfulfilled in Delaware for decades.
- Only 337 reported truck parking spaces and 30+ and growing illegal truck parking clusters identified.
- A completely dwarfed truck parking capacity due to break-neck economic development.
- COVID-19 Global Pandemic tested the resilience, fortitude and commitment of men in women who kept our country alive and moving.
- A new diversion of truck traffic to Delaware due to the Francis Scott Key Bridge collapse.
- New cargo and freight generators.It's simple. I Care.

The first all-female, family, black owned truck stop travel center developer in Delaware Est in 2020.

We are stakeholders, collaborators, residents, and networking community members with a brand, born and bred in Delaware. not just entrepreneurs looking to make a quick buck.

- In addition to our new neighbor Enstructure at Port Delaware North, we have many freight generating facilities that have been authorized to make Delaware their new home.
- By creating truck parking "hubs" in each county, including Resident Truck Driver Parking, we work to reduce the stresses associated with "truck parking insecurity" and anxiety.
- Our goal: 1,500 additional truck parking spaces by 2027. Also, positioning our brand and preparing for the Biden Administration's clean hydrogen initiative, of which Delaware is a member state.



Our 5-phase buildout plan for the next 4 years includes:

Phase 0: Providing Parking



Up to 250 Truck Parking Spaces in the Edgemoor vicinity, and 1,500 more throughout the state.



8-10 Food Trucks for variety, 10k sq. ft. modular amenities-facility including service kitchen, fitness center, walking trail, and self-service pet grooming center.



Well lit, safe, secure, off street and fenced. Formation of our non-profit the Truck Parking Education, Awareness, Advocacy Group or TPEAA Group.



Onsite Mobile Health Units 3x per week for screenings, tests, non-emergency healthcare services.



Phase 1: The Truck Stop Side

- ✓ StripezTruckStop™ Express.
- ✓ Providing mobile ordering and truck side delivery.
- Truck Washing and servicing.
- ✓ Weigh Station/CAT Scale.
- Creating an additional 500 Truck Parking spots statewide.



Phase 2: Travel Center Side:

Additional travel center amenities with 6 proprietary food eateries and retail outlets:


Creating an additional 500 truck parking spots statewide.
