






Median Spending by TIA vs. Future Projected Households: FY 2004 TIP to FY 2025 TIP



Percentage of Workers Commuting via Carpool, since 1980






Fund Transit Management and Expansion














Percentage of Residents Familiar with WILMAPCO






Streamline Freight Movement

FY 2025-2028 TIP Management and Expansion Projects in Truck Bottlenecks



Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations in the WILMAPCO Region, Since 2012




