






Promote Growth in Center TIAs

Household Growth 2000 – 2020




Projected Household Growth 2020 – 2050


Median Spending by TIA vs. Future Projected Households: FY 2004 TIP to FY 2025 TIP


Percentage of Workers Commuting via Carpool, since 1980





**Completed and Funded Segments of the East Coast Greenway in








Percentage of Residents Familiar with WILMAPCO


Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations in the WILMAPCO Region, Since 2012
